


The NEP Course Preference Submission module has now been enabled for students.

The students who have:

- Completed their admission successfully,
- Paid the full admission fee, and
- Have no outstanding balance,

will now be prompted on their dashboard to submit their:

1. **Minor,**
2. **Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) &**
3. **Multi-Disciplinary Course (MDC) preferences.**

The system automatically:

- Displays only the valid Minor options mapped to the admitted Major.
- Excludes the student's Major subject and Class XII subjects from the MDC options, as per NEP guidelines.
- Saves the preference order submitted by the student and allows them to revisit and update it until the submission window closes (if permitted).

Students are advised to complete their course preference submission at the earliest, as course allocation will be carried out based on their submitted preferences and the applicable NEP guidelines.
