All students of the College are hereby informed and encouraged to participate in the IndiaSkills Competition 2026–28, a prestigious national-level platform organised under the aegis of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Government of India, and implemented in Jammu & Kashmir through the J&K Skill Development Mission (JKSDM).

The competition provides an excellent opportunity for young people to showcase their practical skills and talent, gain national recognition, industry exposure and expert mentorship, enhance their career prospects, and potentially progress towards international skill competitions and the WorldSkills Competition.

Who can participate?

Candidates born on or after 01 January 2004 are eligible to participate

Students possessing **skill, talent, practical knowledge, experience and passion** in any of the notified skill areas are encouraged to participate. **Formal education or institutional training in the concerned skill is not essential.**

Candidates must verify the eligibility criteria for a specific skill before registration.

Important Points

- **Participation is completely FREE of cost.**
- The competition covers **63 skill areas** across diverse sectors.
- **Jammu & Kashmir has opted to participate in 32 skills** in the 2026–28 competition.
- Eligible candidates can compete at **State, Regional and National levels**, with opportunities for international progression.
- Students are encouraged to identify the skill area matching their **talent, interest and practical abilities** and register accordingly.
