ONE WEEK FLORICULTURAL TRAINING WORKSHOP ORGANISED BY DEPT. OF BOTANY IN COLLABORATION WITH CSIR SRINAGAR



Department of Botany organised a week long training programme to promote "Floriculture Mission" at S.P. College Srinagar from 18th May to 25th May 2022. The training programme aims to inculcate entrepreneurship approach among the students. The training programme was held in line with the objectives laid by CSIR Srinagar under purview of "Floriculture Mission" which focuses on enhancing financial income of farmers through practical applications of CSIR technologies. Principal S.P. College Prof. (Dr.) Khurshid Ahmad Khan inaugurated the training programme and reiterated the College's commitment for producing job creators than job seekers. He appreciated the Department of Botany for conducting such a skill based training programme. Selected

students from 6th and 7th Semester Botany enrolled for training programme under the mentorship of HoD Botany Prof. Manzoor Ahmand Wani, who is a horticultural expert and a master trainer in the field of nursery and gardening. In the week long programme the students identified spots to be developed as green spaces and participated in the pre and post sowing practices of gladiolus and carnations. A week-long workshop was organized by the Central Library of Sri Pratap College in collaboration with the Department of Information Technology on "Awareness and Use of Information Resources and Services: Step towards implementation of NEP 2020" from 30th May 2022 to 4th June 2022. The aim of the workshop was to make the users aware about the various e-resources subscribed by the Library and encourage students and faculty to make use of these. This was followed by five days Hands on session given to the students in the Browsing centre of the Library facilitated by the faculty of Department of IT and Library staff. The inaugural session of the workshop was held on 30th May 2022 in the college auditorium. The Guest of Honor for this occasion was Prof. (Dr.) Abdul Majid Baba, Dean cum Librarian, Integral University, Lucknow and the Patron was Prof. (Dr.) Khurshid Ahmad Khan, Nodal Officer Kashmir Division Colleges and Principal SP College, Srinagar. The inaugural was followed by two technical sessions preceded by the resource persons: Dr. Sheikh Imran, Assistant Librarian, Allama Iqbal Library, University of Kashmir and Dr. Tariq Ahmad Shah, Assistant Librarian, Central University of Kashmir.

The inaugural function was started by Prof. Ajaz

Magray, (Faculty Dept of IT, S.P.College), who presented a welcome note and mementos as a token of gratitude to the guests. The introduction to the programme was given by Ms. Iram Mahajan, (Librarian S.P. College) who sensitized the audience about the aim and goal of the workshop.

Principal of the college, Prof. (Dr.) Khurshid Ahmad Khan then addressed the audience and emphasized that the purpose of the workshop was to make the faculty and student community aware of the information available to us at the click of a second. He was delighted to share that we have the best possible resources in our library particularly for the student community and made it imperative for the faculty to motivate the students to come forward and utilize the resources.

Dr. Majid Baba was then welcomed on the dais for his address. He, being the alumni of SP College gave a brief introduction of his educational background and his time at SP College, Srinagar. He also enlightened the audience about the history of National Educational Policy (NEP) and NAAC accreditation process in India. He also provided detailed lecture to about the types of information resources viz. Primary, Secondary and Tertiary and gave a concept of data integrity.

The lecture was then followed by a walk to the library made by the Principal, Dr. Khurshid Ahmad Khan, Dr. Wilayat Rizvi, Convenor IQAC, Dr. Shahjahan Wani, Dean Engineering and Technology, Prof Bashir Mir, HOD Chemistry and Dr. Abdul Majid Baba.

After a brief break, the technical session was commenced, wherein the welcome address and deliberation was given by Prof. Zarka Malik from the Department of IT and the presidents for the same were Dr. Mushtaq Zargar, HoD Statistics and Dr. Jan Shabir, HoD Physics. The first resource person, Dr. Sheikh Imran discussed the various E-resources available in this information age. He also compared the various search engines Vs Google. He provided information on the various Searching techniques (using symbols, wildcards) that one can use to get access to more accurate information online and the variation in search results as the search string changes. He also sensitized the audience about the online databases available, thesis, dissertations and journals.

The next technical session was delivered by Dr. Tariq Ahmad Shah who spoke in length about the reliability of our search online when looking for an e-resource. He also gave a step-by-step procedure of using various

e-resources on N-LIST. Next, a detailed deliberation



was given on DELNET and the state wise member libraries registered with it. He also shared the pros and cons of print versus electronic resources.

The final vote of thanks for this session was given by Prof. Zaffar Majeed (Faculty Dept. of IT S. P. College), who thanked the resource persons, the presidents and audience for being with us during the entire session.

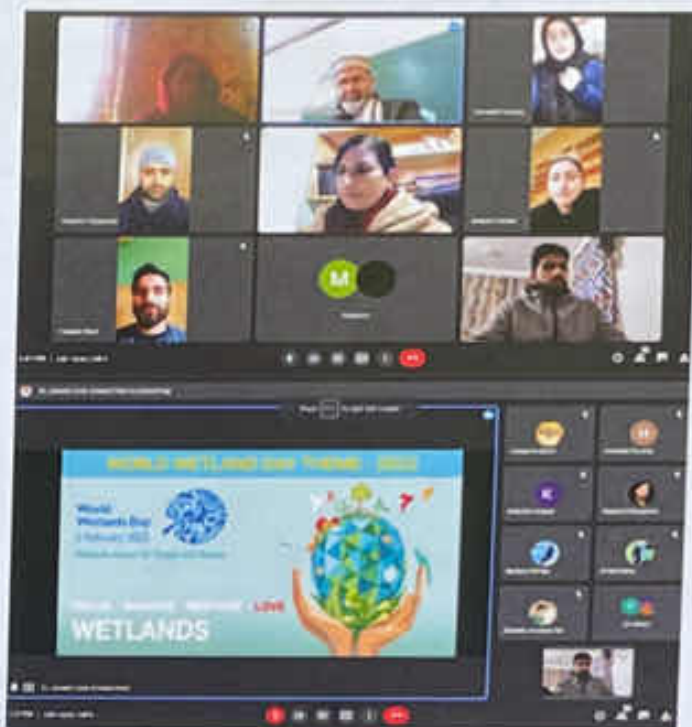
NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

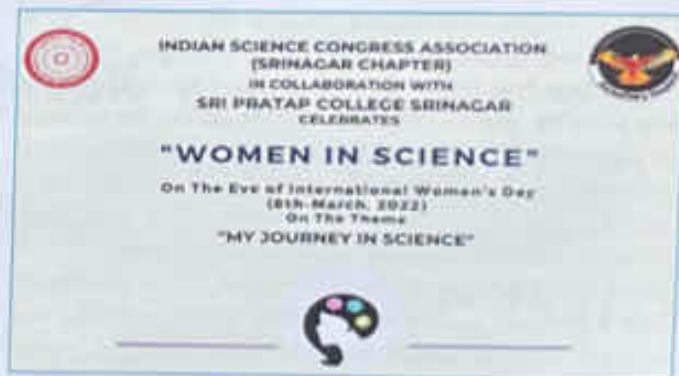
INTERNATIONAL WETLAND DAY

SEMINARS

NATIONAL SEMINAR ON INTERDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH

The Research Hub for Electronics, IT and Computer Sciences, Sri Pratap College, Srinagar today organized a National Seminar on Interdisciplinary Science Research on 24th August 2022. The Seminar focused on the multidisciplinary advancements in research and its aim was to present the multifarious achievements carried out in interdisciplinary research in sciences. He presented a conceptual review of research studies and programs related to interdisciplinary science learning in different boundary-crossing scenarios including within science. BOTANICAL TRIP TO PRANG



With an aim to acquaint the students with floral diversity of local areas students of IG Botany Semester VI were engaged for Botanical trip to Prang on 14th June 2022. Prang is beautiful scenic area located in district Ganderbal. The students were given hands on training about the methods of plant collection and preservation for preparation of herbaria by the accompanying faculty members. Prof. Wilayat Rizvi and Prof. Manzoor Wani (Senior Faculty Members Botany) apprised students about algal diversity in Prang. The taxonomy of the plants was also discussed on spot by Dr. Shabana Aslam (Faculty Member, Botany). The students had experiential learning on varied aspects of plant sciences.

FIELD TECHNIQUES AND SURVEY BASED REPORT FIELD VISIT



The field visit of Field Techniques & Survey Based Report survey was conducted on 30th June 2022 by the Department of Geography with the aim to investigate and analyze the socio-economic aspects and geomorphology of an area from college campus Sri-Pratap College Srinagar to Bandipora. The mode of transport was college bus. The students were given the first-hand information of field survey like how to conduct the field survey and to identify various geomorphological features of the area. About thirty four students were acquainted to different instruments of field studies like Global Positioning System (GPS), Geological Hammer, Burton's Compass and Magnifier.

The first site was Manasbal Lake which is the natural deepest fresh water lake in Kashmir. Dr. Khursheed Ahmad Parry, Coordinator, Department of Geography, gave an insight detail of Landscape of Manasbal and its surrounding rocks and their characteristics and identified rock structures like folds, faults, bedding, dip and strike by observational and scientific methods. The topography around the lake is biogenic limestone in nature and there are possible sink holes in the vicinity. The sources of

the water body are the springs inside the Lake.

The Second site selected was Sadarkote Payeen. The staff including Dr. Feroz Ahmad Wani, Dr. Sameer Fayaz and Ms. Shazia Irshad gave detailed information regarding conducting of Socio-economic survey by schedules. The students were given schedules for household survey which includes demographic setup, household environment, family possessions and livestock parameters. The students successfully filled the information on schedules provided by household members.

The third field site was Wular Lake-one of the largest fresh water in Asia and one of the 49th wetlands designated as Ramsar site. Regarding the Wular Lake Dr Khursheed Parry gave detailed information about how tectonic activity gave origin to Wular Lake. Also the source of water to Wular Lake was observed. The Jhelum, Erin and Madhumati streams supplies water to this lake. Dr. Khursheed also stressed upon the importance of Wular as recharge zone and acts a basin during floods. Willow plantations and siltation were observed as threat to Wular Lake.

INTER-COLLEGE POSTER COMPETITION ON AGEISM



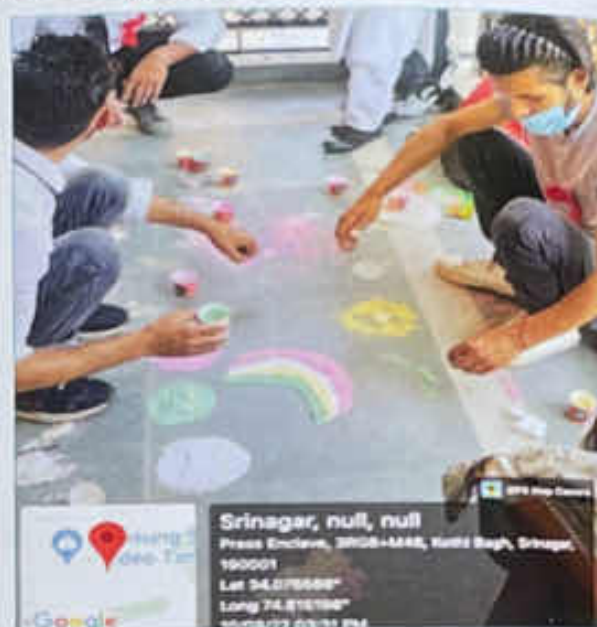
